EQUIPMENT

The following equipment is required at all live fire programs:

- Wrap around ANSI rated eye protection
- Over the ear hearing protection (NRR 18 minimum) (custom molded ear plugs acceptable)
- Body armor
- Cap with visor (hat will be worn with visor facing forward)
- Suitable outer clothing for the anticipated weather conditions
- Adequate water or fluids to remain hydrated

10 Day Basic Firearms Instructor Course

Course Notes:

You will be sent a confirmation letter to attend the 10 Day Basic Firearms Instructor Course if your application is approved. All applicants **MUST** attend the 1 Day Pre-Qualification and meet the qualification standards. All 10 Days are required to receive certification.

Select Fire (Full Auto) Instructor certification will be offered at selected programs.

Attendees may bring training ammo for this program. Duty ammo is not required. Total ammo count includes the Pre-Qualification shoot.

You will be given a course CD on the first day of the course. You should print out the required documents for the next day's classroom. A three ring binder is recommended to keep handouts and notes organized.

10 Day Basic Instructor Certification Course

Pistol	1500 Rounds
Shotgun	250 Rounds
Patrol rifle	1000 Rounds

Bring dummy rounds in the appropriate caliber for your handgun, rifle and shotgun.

Firearms Instructor Recertification - 1 Day Course

Ammunition Requirement

Pistol	300 Rounds	12 ga. tail stabilized bean bag type	10 rounds
Shotgun	75 Rounds	40mm single projectile foam baton	10 rounds*
Patrol rifle	200 Rounds	12 ga. Less Lethal Shotgun	
Revolver	150 Rounds	40mm Launcher*	

Bring dummy rounds in the appropriate caliber for your handgun, rifle and shotgun

**Loaner 40mm launchers available from MPTC. 40mm rounds available for sale from Interstate Arms, Jurek Bros. or Milton Walsh Associates. Contact the Firearms Coordinator for more information. You are responsible for supplying a less lethal shotgun and 12 ga. Less Lethal rounds. Order Less Lethal rounds at least 6 weeks in advance.*

Frangible ammo only at the Foxboro Range

Firearms Equipment:

- Semi-auto Pistol
- 3 pistol magazines
- Shotgun with sling
- Patrol rifle with sling
- Extra magazine for rifle
- Revolver

Related Equipment:

- Cleaning equipment, Handi-wipes
- Knee and/or elbow pads
- Shooters mat
- Full duty belt
- Revolver holster and speed loaders

Wear appropriate clothing for a day at the range. Be prepared to lie on the ground to shoot prone.

*******Important Notice to Firearms Instructors*******

- All Firearm Instructors are **required achieve a minimum score of 94%** or better to qualify.
- You must have **Zero (0) misses** at the 3, 5 and 7 yard lines.
- You may only have at least 8 hits at the 15 yd stage and 9 hits at the 10 yd stage.
- You must maintain **100% round accountability. All rounds must be within target silhouette.** Rounds must be within the “Q” to score points.

12 ga. Less Lethal Shotgun	
40mm Launcher*	

*MPTC has a limited number of 40mm launchers to loan for these classes. If you have a 40mm launcher, please bring it to the class. MPTC will be making bulk purchases of less lethal ammo for training. If you need ammo, please contact the Firearms Coordinator to determine availability and price.

- Ball cap

Ammunition Requirements:

Pistol 250 Rounds
Patrol rifle 500 Rounds

Firearms Equipment:

- Semi-auto Pistol
- Patrol rifle with sling

Related Equipment:

Cleaning equipment, Hand wipes
3 magazines for pistol
Knee & Elbow Pads
Mat, Appropriate Weather Gear for the Day
Lunch, Depending on Range Location

Patrol rifles must be equipped with iron sights.
